- Cash Payments: Payments made in cash must be the exact amount.
- Weather-Appropriate Clothing: With the changing weather, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately.
- Extra Clothing: Please provide at least two sets of weather-appropriate extra clothes for your child to keep in their cubby.
- Labeling Belongings: Ensure that all of your child's belongings are clearly labeled with their first and last name to prevent misplacement.
- Trick-or-Treat Safety: Please stay safe while trick-or-treating and be aware of your surroundings.
- School Hours: Tiny Thinkers operates Monday through Friday, from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm. We also offer extended care from 6:30 am to 7:30 am and 5:30 pm to 6:00 pm.
- Payment Deadline: Please make timely payments to avoid the \$35 late fee.
- Pickup Protocol: Ensure that all individuals listed on your child's contact card bring a valid picture ID and are at least 18 years old when picking up your child from the center.

- Sign-In/Out Procedures: Please remember to sign your child in at drop-off and out at pick-up every day, on both the corresponding clipboard and CCRC/DCFS documents.
- Doorbell Reminder: We kindly ask all parents to ring the doorbell when arriving to pick up your child, even if another parent has already rung it.
