**Challenging Behaviors**: Biting: Why is my child biting? How can I prevent it?

Biting is a behavior often observed in infants and toddlers. It is not uncommon for children of this age group to explore and express themselves in various ways and biting can be one of them when they are unable to express themselves. Though this behavior may be concerning to many, it is crucial to approach the topic with understanding and patience. Our staff are determined to create a comfortable, supportive and safe environment for all the children. There are alternative ways that may help staff and parents actively work on effective ways to teach the child to communicate and express their feelings. We encourage parents to work closely with teachers to promote parent-teacher partnerships as we can develop strategies to minimize and address the behavior. We are here to support you and your child during these formative years.
