September Reminders

- Annual Material Fee: The \$120 annual material fee per child for the 2025–2026 school year is now due
- Contact Card Updates: Please update your child's Contact Card with current information. Be sure to complete both the top and bottom sections one copy will remain in your child's file, and the other will be placed in our emergency contact book.
- Clothing Exchange Seasonal Update: Fall begins on **September 22nd.** Please refresh your child's cubby with appropriate fall clothing as the weather changes.
- Reasons for a child who may not be admitted to the center include:
 - o Non-payment of tuition
 - o Improper attire (open-toe shoes or lack of hygiene)
 - o Signs of illness
 - o Arrival after 10:00 AM without prior notice

- Late Arrival Policy: Children arriving after 10:00 AM will not be admitted unless the school is notified in advance of a doctor, dentist, or WIC appointment, with a note provided. In these cases, arrival must be no later than 11:30 AM.
- Sick Days: If your child is absent due to illness for more than 2 days, please provide a note explaining the reason upon their return.
- **Medication:** If your child requires medication during school hours, a *Consent for Medication* form must be completed and submitted.
- Naptime Requirements: All children must bring a fitted crib sheet (size: 28in x 52in / 71.1cm x 132cm) for naptime.
- Water Cups: Please bring a straw water bottle or zippy cup with a secure lid for water only. Cups will be sent home daily to be washed and must be returned the next day.
- **Birthday Celebrations:** If you would like to celebrate your child's birthday at school, please complete and return the *Birthday Celebration Form* in advance.

Why Immunizations Matter

Vaccines protect children from serious diseases such as measles, whooping cough, and polio, while also safeguarding those who are too young or unable to be vaccinated.

Benefits of Preventive Visits

- Track growth and development
- Screen vision, hearing, and developmental milestones
- Update immunizations
- Receive guidance on nutrition, sleep, and safety
- Strengthen the relationship with your child's doctor

What Well-Child Visits Include

- Complete physical exam and screenings
- Immunization updates
- Developmental and behavioral check-ins
- Dedicated time to ask your doctor questions
