#### October Reminders:

- Mosquito Season is Still Buzzing: If you'd like insect repellent applied to your child during the day, please be sure to provide a labeled bottle of repellent & complete a Medication Consent Form at the front desk
- Cooler Days Are Coming Extra Clothes Needed! Please send at least two full sets of weather-appropriate extra clothes (tops, bottoms, socks, etc.) to keep in your child's cubby accidents, spills, and chilly days happen!
- Label, Label! Help us keep track of all your child's belongings by making sure everything is clearly labeled with their first and last name jackets, lunchboxes, water bottles, you name it!
- Trick-or-Treat Safety Tips: Whether you're joining us at school or celebrating in your neighborhood: Stay alert and be cautious of surroundings. Avoid costumes with masks that block visibility. Always trick-or-treat with a grown-up
- Dress for the Season: Please ensure your child has an appropriate weather jacket or sweater in their cubby for those cooler October mornings and afternoons.
