January Reminders

- Weather-Appropriate Clothing
The weather remains cold. Please make sure your child comes to school dressed in warm, weather-appropriate clothing each day.
- Daily Sign-In and Sign-Out
Please remember that signing your child in and out each day is required and is an important part of our school safety policy. Families enrolled through CCRC must also sign the appropriate CCRC page in the sign-in book.
- Sick Policy
If your child is feeling unwell or showing any symptoms of illness, please keep them home and consult your physician before returning to school. If a child arrives with symptoms or becomes uncomfortable during the day, parents will be notified. With flu season still active, we ask all families to take extra precautions to help keep our children and staff healthy.
- School Payments
If making a payment by check, please include your child's full first and last name in the memo line, along with the purpose of the payment.

- Reporting Injuries at Home

If your child is injured at home, please inform your child's teacher during morning drop-off so we can properly document and monitor as needed.

- Reporting Absences

If your child is out sick, please contact the school to help us maintain accurate attendance records and monitor the overall health of the center.

- Toys From Home

Please keep all toys at home unless it is a designated sharing day. The school is not responsible for any toys that are lost or broken.

Finding the right school for your child:

Beginning your search early is one of the best steps you can take, especially when preparing for Transitional Kindergarten (TK) or Kindergarten. Early enrollment helps ensure your child is ready for a strong start and prevents last-minute challenges. The beginning of the school year is an important adjustment period for students and teachers. Because many schools close for the summer, families are encouraged to complete enrollment well before the first day of school.
