



What to Pack for the First Day of Preschool

It's finally happening - your little one is heading off to school!

Dropping your child off at preschool can be stressful, regardless of whether they've been in daycare for years or have been at home with you. Starting preschool can be an adjustment for both you and your child. However, the good news is that it gets easier quickly.

Enrollment Forms

Whether it's a sippy cup or another spill-proof option, choose a water bottle your child can easily open on their own. Staying hydrated is important during a busy day of activities.

Extra Set of Clothes and Socks

Preschoolers can get messy, so pack a seasonally appropriate extra outfit, including a pair of socks.

Extra Underwear

Even if your child is potty-trained, accidents can happen.

Diapers, Wipes, and Cream

If your child is not yet potty-trained, please send an adequate supply of diapers, wipes, and diaper cream.

Seasonal Outerwear

We spend time outdoors daily, so please dress your child appropriately for the weather. On chilly days, send a coat; on sunny days, pack a hat.

Nap Time Essentials

We provide cots. Please send a fitted sheet and a blanket.

Sunscreen

The sun's rays can be strong year-round, so sunscreen is important.

Any Necessary Medication

If your child requires daily medication or has any allergies, please inform the school in advance.
